

Club Competition Format - 2010

- There will be 9 club competitions
- Annual awards will be based on the competitors' best 7 results
- 4 of the 9 competitions will be held at Little Beach including Easter Sunday. 3 will be held at Swansea. The other 2 will be held at Hat Head and Forster.
- Points towards annual awards will be awarded on a percentage basis at each club competition with scores allocated as a percentage of the highest score.
- In addition to annual age champion awards, four grade (A, B, C & D) champions and runners up will be recognised. Grades will be determined at the beginning of the competition year and will remain unaltered for that year.
- Handicap competition will not run
- 8 individual awards will be made for each competition. These are Most Meritorious Fish in each grade (this award only based on ABC system North Zone not normal competition scoring) and highest score in each grade. These awards will be \$20 for 2010.
- In addition an Open Competition based on the [Victorian Spearfishing Challenge](#) will be organised by Steve Elias and sponsored by Fingal Bay Rec Club, called [The Neptunes Challenge](#) The 10 species eligible are
 1. Kingfish (any)
 2. Rock Blackfish
 3. Bream
 4. Flathead (any)
 5. Bonito
 6. Silver Trumpeter
 7. Salmon
 8. Luderick
 9. Morwong (any)
 10. Leatherjacket (any)

Fish have to be speared in NSW waters (not necessarily competitions). The heaviest of each of the 10 species receives 10 points, second heaviest 9 points, etc. Only 2 weigh-ins per species allowed and there will be a time limit for registration of fish. Full details of the competition will be on the club's website when details are finalised.

- An effort will be made to post all competitors' results within one week of competitions to keep members informed.
